Essential Job Function

Performs a variety of general parks work, mowing, trimming, weed eating, general cleaning, and all other jobs assigned.

Accountability

Works under the supervision of the Parks Supervisor.

Employment Status

The Employee filling this position is a non-exempt position and is “at will”.

Job Duties

1. Maintains North Ogden Parks through a schedule of mowing, trimming, weed eating and snow removal.
2. Monitor parks for problems in maintenance, looking for things such as: water leaks, holes, broken sprinkler heads, problems in the restrooms and reports problems to supervisor.
3. Ensures the cleanliness of facilities through maintenance of bowery's and restrooms, parking areas, sports areas, and the lawns.
4. Maintains the equipment they use: (fuel, check oil, and keep clean)
5. Assists with tree, sod, shrub planting, and other greenery. Assists with tree and shrub trimming and removal of such. Participates in the installation and repair of sprinkler systems.
6. Other duties as assigned.

Education, Experience, and Training Requirements

1. Skill in the operation of various types of light equipment such as riding lawn mowers, small tractor loaders, basic mechanics, and ability to recognize mechanical problems.
2. Have a valid Utah Drivers license.

Working Conditions

Tasks require variety of physical activities, generally involving some muscular strain, such as walking, standing, stooping, sitting, reaching, etc. Talking, hearing, and seeing is essential to the performance of the job. Common eye, hand, finger dexterity exists. Mental application utilizes memory for details, verbal instructions, emotional stability, dexterity thinking and creative problem solving. Frequent local travel required in normal course of job performance.
