






REAWAKING NATURE & CONNECTING THE COMMUNITY




Washington Boulevard is re-imagined to include a planted median, shared use path on both sides, pedestrian improvements and an increased tree canopy while maintaining the existing traffic volume.



The Festival Street includes on-street parallel parking and parking in the center of the street. Parking can be closed down to make room for festivals and events. Slow street speeds allow for pedestrian crossings throughout the street.



Re-introducing the creek to the site creates an engaging environment for people to gather, dine, and shop while enjoying a pleasant outdoor environment
