

DECLARATION 2022-01

CRITICAL WATER EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS: North Ogden City owns and maintains its own culinary water system;
and

WHEREAS: During 2022 the drought conditions have caused issues with water
availability; and

WHEREAS: North Ogden City springs have reached significantly reduced levels;
and

WHEREAS: It is in the best interest of The City to utilize the water sources in a
way which is most beneficial to residents and the community; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor is empowered through City Ordinances to declare a
critical water emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Neal Berube hereby declares a critical water
emergency and provide the following guidelines for water usage:**

- No Culinary Water shall be used to irrigate turf or other plants which can survive on limited to no water.
- Culinary Water can be used to water trees, shrubs, gardens, and flowers, through the use of hoses and direct watering in the event secondary water is unavailable.
- Culinary use for food production is allowed by permit approved by Public Works Director.
- Culinary Water can be used to water livestock.
- Culinary Water can be used for all regular sanitary needs, like bathing, washing clothes, etc.
- Anyone violating this declaration is subject to the penalties outlined in North Ogden Code 9-2-4.
