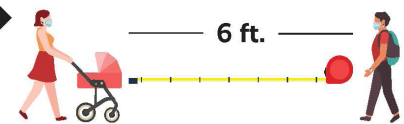
## Parks Are Essential, Especially During a Health Crisis



An overwhelming majority of adults in the United States find exercising at their local parks, trails, and open spaces essential to maintaining their mental and physical health during the COVID-19 pandemic. Over half (59 percent) note it is very or extremely essential to be able to walk, jog, hike and/or bike, with parents even more likely to feel this way (68 percent). You should keep physical distancing parameters in mind whenever visiting our local parks, trails or other open space.

### Tips for Physical Distancing In Parks

Know what 6 feet looks like. Lay measuring tape on the ground. It's the distance of a surfboard, long yoga mat or adult bike.



Do not use playgrounds or other frequently touched surfaces.

Go by yourself or those you live with. Strongly consider the use of a face covering.



Avoid crowded areas. If a space cannot be enjoyed safely, go home or discover a new park in your community.

## Green Waste Pick Up May 11-15

Collection will be on your regular garbage day. The volume of material may, however, delay collection a day or two. The regulations mentioned below MUST be followed when placing material out for collection.



- Weight limit is 75 pounds.
- All materials must be in boxes, bundled with string, or bagged.
- Bush clippings and small tree limbs must be bundled and no longer than 5 feet in length.
- Place materials in parkways, not in curb or waterways.

- Large household trash items (furniture, mattresses, bed frames, etc.)
- Used tires and car batteries
- Green waste including branches, leaves, weeds, etc.
- Paint (must be dried with kitty litter)
- Cardboard, plastic and glass
- Appliances and electronics
- Used oil will be accepted by **Jiffy Lube** and **Auto Zone**

**Not Accepted**

- NO Commercial waste or dumping
- Regular household garbage
- Hazardous waste or materials
- Waste from residents of other cities
