PUBLIC WORKS



As we enter the 2020-2021 budget year and try to navigate through COVID times, the Public Works office has had to make some adjustments to procedures and the way we can best serve residents. As many of you know, we have chosen to discontinue the recycling program due to the cost of recycling and the restrictions in place to guarantee recycling policies are adhered to. In order to still be able to utilize the blue cans many of our residents have, we have opted to continue emptying the blue cans every other week, but they are no longer restricted to just recycling products. Please use your blue can at your convenience as an overflow garbage can and continue to put it out on the designated pick up weeks. If the blue can is put out any other time, it will not be emptied due to the contract we have in place.

GREEN WASTE PASSES

Another change we have made concerns Green Waste passes. In order to allow residents to still be able to use the Green Waste Pit while offices are closed to the public, we will be selling entry passes over the phone by calling 801-782-8111. Payments can be made by using a Visa or Mastercard (debit cards work as well). Once a pass is purchased it will be delivered to the Green Waste Pit and available for pick up from there by residents **Monday and Wednesday between 4-6 PM** or **Saturday between 9-2 PM**. If you purchase a pass after 2 PM on a day the pit is open, you will not be permitted to enter the green waste
