

Map





























### Existing Conditions

# Why the Need . . .

- Extraordinary costs of development discourage current development
  - Relocation of storm detention basin
  - Demolition of structures
  - Road improvements to facilitate development
  - Burying of power lines
  - County islands disrupt distribution of development costs
- Blighted appearance of multiple properties
- Vacant structures in area are not attracting tenants

#### **Development Assumptions**

- North Node 230,000 sf of commercial space
- South Node
  - Approximately 26 acre development:
  - 140 senior housing units (apprx. 8 acres)
  - Mixed-use Project (apprx. 18 acres)
- Base Year Taxable Value: \$16,913,911
- Infill and redevelopment of blighted properties


