Under a class "B" beer license, a licensee my sell beer only to persons who purchase a meal at the restaurant. Beer may be sold only for on-premises consumption and may not be taken off the premises.
- 13. The applicant shall enclose the application fee with this application. If the City determines that it will issue the bee license, the City will notify the applicant, who shall pay the license fee prior to the issuance of the license. Fees are set by resolution of the City Council. The applicant should contact the City for a current list of fees.
