Summary of Responsibilities

Under general supervision of a patrol sergeant, performs general duties of police work in the enforcement of laws, maintenance of order, protection of life and property, and prevention of crime.

Some assignments in the police department include patrol, investigations, school resource officer, SWAT, Narcotics Strike Force, K9, and bike patrol.

Minimum Qualifications

- A high school or equivalent graduate.
- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Possess a Utah driver license.
- Good moral character as determined by a background investigation.
- Free of any physical, emotional, or mental conditions, which might adversely affect the performance of duty as a police officer.
- Must be able to effectively communicate verbally, in writing, and be computer literate.

- Up to 6% into 401(k)
- Health and dental insurance
- Vacation (80 hours 1st year) and sick leave
- 13 paid holidays
