

ORDINANCE 2021- 17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NORTH OGDEN CITY CODE RELATED TO THE STORAGE OF INOPERABLE VEHICLES

WHEREAS: The City has been given authority by the state to enact ordinances and regulate the expenditures of taxes received; and

WHEREAS: The City believe in protecting property values and protecting residents from nuisances; and

WHEREAS: The City has been given the authority to regulate the accumulation of clutter and other things; and

WHEREAS: The City desires to clarify the requirements for storing vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the North Ogden City Council that the North Ogden City Code be amended as follows.

SECTION 1: The North Ogden Code Title 5 Chapter 1 subsection 2 be amended to read.

5-1-2: INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLE STORAGE

1. Inoperable Defined: For the purposes of this chapter, a motor vehicle, boat, recreational vehicle or trailer shall be deemed inoperable if it is not currently licensed, as required by state code, or operable for the use for which it was intended. The same shall be deemed abandoned if it has been left unattended for a period of seven (7) days or more upon any public or private property.
2. Fence Required: Any inoperable or abandoned vehicle must be stored in an enclosed structure or behind an opaque six foot (6') fence, which is intended to shield the vehicle from view from any adjoining public or private property.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take immediate effect.
