

**ORDINANCE 2022-03**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE NORTH OGDEN CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING CITY ORDINANCE TITLE 1 CHAPTER 5 SECTION 6 TO ESTABLISH AN ORDER OF SUCCESSION IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS** North Ogden City desires to have an updated and efficient Emergency Operation Plan ("EOP"); and

**WHEREAS** an effective EOP requires clear succession of municipal governance in the event of an emergency, and

**WHEREAS** the North Ogden Ordinances do not currently provide for succession beyond the Mayor Pro Tempore, and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the North Ogden City Council that the following section be added North Ogden City Municipal Code Title 1 Chapter 5 Section 6

**1-5-6: GOVERNMENTAL SUCCESSION**

- A. In the event of an emergency the Powers of the Mayor shall remain with the Mayor as long as they are able to perform their duties.
  - 1. Should the Mayor be unable to perform their duties in the event of an emergency the following shall be the order of succession
    - a. Mayor
    - b. Mayor Pro Tempore
    - c. Most Senior Member of City Council (based on years of service)
    - d. City Manager/Administrator

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall take immediate effect.


