## **ORDINANCE 2024 - 01**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING TITLE 7: MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 3: STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, SUBSECTION 4: WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS, ADDRESSING COMMERCIAL PARKING DURING SNOWSTORMS IN NORTH OGDEN CITY.

WHEREAS; North Ogden City adopts and updates its Traffic Code, including a Winter Parking

Regulations Ordinance adopted by Ordinance 2010-11 on October 12, 2010; and

WHEREAS; North Ogden City maintains the streets and public ways in a safe manner during

snowstorms; and

WHEREAS; North Ogden City businesses are asking for flexibility of on-street parking during

snowstorms; and

WHEREAS; The City Council periodically adopts new standards for the City to consider use

and enjoyment of property.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the North Ogden City Council that the North Ogden City adopts amendments to Title 7-3-4: Winter Parking Regulations.

**SECTION 1:** The text below is hereby amended and adopted for North Ogden City within "7-3-4: Winter Parking Regulations".

## 7-3-4: WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS

1. Definitions: As used in this section, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

PARK, PARKED AND PARKING: The standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers.

SNOWSTORM: An event of snowfall which is anticipated to result in accumulations of snow sufficient to necessitate the removal of snow from the public streets and roadways.

VEHICLE: Any device, means or mechanism in or on which persons, goods or other items of personal property may be carried from one place to another. "Vehicle" includes, but is not limited to, automobiles, trucks, trailers of all kinds, motorcycles, off highway vehicles, motor homes, recreational vehicles, and tractors.

## 2. Prohibited Parking:

 It is unlawful for the owner of any vehicle to park his or her vehicle, or allow his or her vehicle to be parked, on any public street or roadway in the city between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. from November 15 through March 15 of each year, except for physicians or emergency vehicles in emergency situations.

- 2. It is unlawful for the owner of any vehicle to park his or her vehicle, or allow his or her vehicle to be parked, on any public street or roadway in the city during any snowstorm or within twenty-four (24) hours following the cessation of snow after any snowstorm.
- 3. During business hours, employees may park in legal parking areas on a public street within 200 feet of the location of a commercially zoned business, including during a snowstorm, and within twenty-four (24) hours following the cessation of snow after a snowstorm.
  - 1. All vehicles which are parked on the roadway during a snowstorm are responsible for any damage sustained to their vehicle by snowplows whether directly or indirectly damaged by the plow or discharge of snow.
- 3. Penalty: A violation of this section may be charged as a civil violation.
- 4. Removal: Any vehicle found parked in violation of this section shall be deemed a public nuisance and may be removed or towed away by or under the direction of the police department or the department of public works.

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall take immediate effect and shall apply to any property which has not submitted a complete application as of the date of this ordinance or allowed any approvals to lapse after the adoption of this ordinance.
